Unit	Old	New Writing Changes
Unit 5-1 Poetry	Write a poem about their favorite flower or tree and draw a picture of it.	No Change – Everyone needs to make sure to do this!
Unit 6-1 Opinion Writing	Write a sentence to tell your opinion about a <u>season</u> you like and tell why you like it.	No Change!
Unit 6-2 Opinion Writing	Write sentences about things they like to do on rainy days.	Write sentences to tell why you do or do not like rainy days and give at least 1 reason why. (slight change from manual)
Unit 6-3 Opinion Writing	Write a weather report	You are going to give the writing prompt this week. See the line below!
Unit 6 Opinion Writing Prompt	Write a sentence about weather you like. Draw a picture of it.	Writing Prompt – Write a sentence about a type of weather you like <u>and tell at least 1 reason why you like it.</u> (slight change from Wonders writing prompt)
Unit 7-1 Informational Writing	Create an animal card	Write a report about a given baby animal. (Change from manual, however we did this last year!)
Unit 7-2 Informational Writing	Write about how to take care of a pet	Write a report about a given pet. Tell at least 2 facts that you have learned. (Slight change from manual, however we did this last year!)
Unit 7-3 Informational Writing	Write questions/answers about animals	Write a report about a given habitat. Tell at least 2 facts that you have learned.

Unit 7	Writing Prompt – Draw a picture of an animal. Write a sentence about it.	<u>DO NOT give a writing prompt for Unit 7!</u> We are going to continue Information Writing into Unit 8!
Unit 8-1 Informational Writing	Write a story about traveling somewhere.	Write a report about trains. Tell at least 2 facts that you have learned.
Unit 8-2 Informational Writing	Make a travel poster about a place they would like to visit.	Write a report about Mount Rushmore. Tell at least 2 facts that you have learned.
Unit 8-3 Informational Writing	Write a counting book about things they see in the sky.	You are going to give the Writing prompt this week. See the line below!
Unit 8 Informational Writing Prompt	Writing Prompt – Write a sentence and draw a picture about how you go to school.	Give Informational Writing Prompt – Write a report about bats. Tell at least 2 facts that you have learned. (Change from the manual; however we did give this prompt last year at the end of unit 7.)
Unit 9-1 Narrative Writing	Write an opinion about a book they choose.	Write about a time you helped out at home.
Unit 9-2 Narrative Writing	Write a story that is organized and has a beginning, middle, and end.	Write a story about a time you helped someone at school or in your community.
Unit 9-3 Narrative Writing	Write a recipe	Write about a time you made something. This could be food, craft, other.
Unit 9 Narrative Writing	Writing Prompt – Write about a chore you do at home.	<u>DO NOT give a writing prompt for Unit 9!</u> We are going to continue Narrative Writing into Unit 10!
Unit 10-1 Narrative Writing	Write a story with dialogue about people who share ideas	Write a story about a time you were sad or scared.

Unit 10-2 Narrative Writing	Write a thank you note	You are going to give the Narrative Writing Prompt this week. See the line below!
Unit 10 Narrative Writing Prompt	Write about a time you have helped someone.	Give Narrative Writing Prompt – Write a story about a happy or fun time you’ve had with family or friends.
